It's all about Respect, Manaakitanga

Information for older people and their families using this Age Concern Service

There is a network of over 25 Services nationwide which includes:

- Professional Coordinators trained to work with older people and their families
- An Advisory Group of expert professionals who assist the Age Concern Coordinator
- Experienced Educators who deliver training for aged care workers and public awareness to interested organisations and groups

What does the Coordinator do?

- Provides free, confidential advice
- Responds to situations where an older person's safety or wellbeing is at risk
- Provides assessment and intervention services if this is agreed to
- Supports older people to make their own decisions about matters that concern them
- Works co-operatively with family and service providers
- Refers to other service providers as necessary (e.g. health, solicitor, etc)
- Supports clients to live safely

What happens when I contact the Service?

- You will be asked for your contact details and what you would like help with
- You may choose to remain anonymous
- If appropriate, the Age Concern Coordinator will offer to assess the situation
- The safety and wellbeing of the older person will be the main consideration
- The wishes of the older person will be respected



Who will know about the information I share with the Coordinator?

- The information you share will be treated confidentially
- The Age Concern Coordinator may ask for your permission to speak with your family or friends or other services involved with your care (e.g. home support provider, doctor, bank)
- If you do not wish the Age Concern Coordinator to contact someone, your wishes will be respected
- The Service is regularly audited by government officials. They may wish to look at your file to make sure that you are receiving a good service. If they do this, they will treat everything they see as confidential and will not disclose any personal information about you to anyone else
